LEADING OFF

ANOTHER SHOT AT SERIES W

- Arkansas gets a second opportunity to clinch its SEC-leading 14th consecutive series win on Saturday afternoon.
- First pitch in the series finale between the Razorbacks and Gators is set for noon CT on SEC Network+ with Mick Hubert (play-by-play) and Nick Belmonte (analyst) on the call.

STILL STREAKING

- Arkansas boasts the league's longest active consecutive series win streak (13) as well as the SEC's second-longest consecutive away series win streak (6).
- The Razorbacks also own the SEC's longest consecutive home series win streak (10).
- Vanderbilt (2012-14) and Florida (2017-18) share the record for most consecutive SEC series wins (15).

ROAD HOGS

- The Hogs have won six consecutive SEC road series and are 9-2 in their last 11 SEC road series.
- Including Friday night's 8-1 win over the Gators, Arkansas has won the opening game of its last nine SEC road series.
- With a win in Sunday's series finale at Florida Ballpark, Arkansas can clinch its first series win in Gainesville since the 2012 campaign.

SOOIEVILLE SLUGGERS

- Arkansas has belted 45 home runs through 29 games this year.
- OF Braydon Webb has slugged a team-leading eight homers to pace the Razorbacks this season.
- The Hogs hit a nation-best 109 homers in 63 games last year, setting a singleseason program record in the process.
- Six Hogs posted double-digit homer totals in 2021, including INF Robert Moore (team-high 16), OF Brady Slavens (14) and INF Cayden Wallace (14).

NATIONALLY SPEAKING

- Arkansas entered this weekend's action ranked 13th nationally in strikeouts per nine innings (11.0), 14th in hits allowed per nine innings (7.3), 16th in WHIP (1.21) and 18th in earned run average (3.57).
- Defensively, Arkansas has been superb with a .985 fielding percentage, which tops the SEC and is fourth nationally.

TAKE A BOW, DYLAN LEACH

- C Dylan Leach became only the second Razorback since 1994 to hit for the cycle, going 5-for-5 with two home runs (one from each side of the batter's box) and five RBI in Arkansas' wild 21-9 win over UCA on Tuesday night.
- Moore also hit for the cycle last year in a midweek game against UCA.

Junior infielder **Robert Moore** is a consensus preseason All-American entering the 2022 campaign and one of the top college prospects ahead of the 2022 MLB Draft.

MOORE OF THE SAME

- INF Robert Moore, one of the best college baseball players in the country last year, is expected to do more of the same in 2022.
- Moore slashed .283/.384/.558 with a team-leading 16 home runs and 53 RBI in 2021, his first full season with the Razorbacks.
- The Leawood, Kan., native established himself as one of college baseball's premier middle infielders, earning All-SEC, Newcomer All-SEC and SEC All-Defensive praise after the year.
- Moore became the first Razorback in program history to earn
 Freshman All-America status in multiple seasons, landing on
 Baseball America's Freshman All-America Team in 2021 after he was
 named to Collegiate Baseball's Freshman All-America Team in 2020.
- The switch-hitting infielder enters 2022 as a consensus preseason All-American as well as a watch list honoree for the Golden Spikes Award, mostly recently won by Arkansas RHP Kevin Kopps.
- MLB scouts and talent evaluators will have their eyes on Moore all season long. Baseball America ranks him as the No. 8 overall college prospect for the 2022 MLB Draft as well as the second-best second baseman among all college prospects.
- D1Baseball ranks Moore as the No. 10 college prospect and the second-best collegiate second baseman ahead of the 2022 draft.

NEW NUMBER, SAME JB

- One of the nation's top shortstops a year ago, INF Jalen Battles opted to not sign during the 2021 MLB Draft and return to Arkansas.
- Battles, a native of San Antonio, Texas, slashed .269/.371/.407 with six homers and 43 RBI in 2021, his first season at Arkansas after transferring from McLennan Community College in Waco, Texas.
- He hit .538 with seven base knocks, including a double and a homer, five RBI and five runs scored in the 2021 SEC Tournament to earn MVP honors and help Arkansas win its first SEC Tournament title.
- The slick-handed infielder, who wore No. 4 in 2021, now sports the highly sought-after No. 2, which previously belonged to Arkansas head baseball coach Dave Van Horn.
- Van Horn wore the number as a player at Arkansas in 1982 and had donned it since his first season at the helm of his alma mater in 2003. The Razorback skipper, however, struck a deal with Battles that allowed him to don the number if he returned to Arkansas for his senior year in 2022.

TURNER TIME

- C/INF Michael Turner, one of two graduate transfers to join the Hogs this offseason, is in his first year at Arkansas after spending the initial four seasons of his collegiate career at Kent State (2018-21).
- The Warren, Ohio, native earned All-MAC honors in 2019 after hitting .369/.448/.539 with four homers and 42 RBI while posting a .982 fielding percentage and throwing out 12 attempted base stealers.
- Over his four seasons at Kent State, Turner slashed .322./.413/.481
 with 11 homers and 88 RBI in 118 games with 107 starts.

LANZO

- Like Turner, OF Chris Lanzilli is in his first year at Arkansas after joining the program as a graduate transfer from Wake Forest, where he spent the first four seasons of his career (2018-21).
- The Stoneham, Mass., native appeared in 170 games with 166 starts while at Wake Forest, finishing his career with a .298 batting average and 195 hits, 147 RBI, 42 home runs, 46 doubles and 76 walks.
- Lanzilli's 46 career homers are the fifth-most home runs among all active Division I college baseball players.

THE LOUISIANIMAL

- INF Peyton Stovall is one of the Razorbacks' highly touted newcomers garnering a ton of preseason of hype.
- The Haughton, La., native was a projected first-round pick in the 2021 MLB Draft before he withdrew his name in order to attend Arkansas.
- Stovall was picked as the Preseason SEC Freshman of the Year by both D1Baseball and Baseball America.

CAPTAIN CAYDEN

- Voted a team captain as a sophomore by his teammates, INF/OF Cayden Wallace's value to Arkansas cannot be overstated.
- The Greenbrier, Ark., native burst onto the scene as a true freshman in 2021, becoming the 24th Razorback in program history to earn Freshman All-America status after slashing .279/.369/.500 with 14 homers and 44 RBI on the year.
- The young slugger's 14 homers matched OF Heston Kjerstad's mark (14) for the Arkansas freshman record for home runs in a season as he helpd the Razorbacks hit a school-record 109 home runs in 2021.
- Wallace enters 2022 as a preseason All-SEC Second Team honoree at third as well as a watch list honoree for the Golden Spikes Award.

Senior pitcher **Connor Noland**, a former quarterback for the Arkansas football team, has shown he has what it takes to be the Razorbacks' Friday night starter.

$QB1 = SP^{1}$

- SP Connor Noland has displayed ace-like qualities through his seven starts on the mound this season.
- The Hogs' Friday night starter owns a 5-1 record with a team-leading 2.61 ERA in 48.1 innings, striking out 60 batters to just 10 walks.
- Noland has logged a team-best five quality starts on the year, most recently spinning a seven-inning, seven-strikeout masterpiece on the road against Florida (April 7).
- In 2019, Noland was named a Freshman All-American by Perfect Game and earned a spot on the SEC All-Freshman Team after making 19 starts and going 3-5 with a 4.02 ERA in 78.1 innings of work.
- Noland, a native of Greenwood, Ark., began his career at Arkansas as a quarterback on the Razorback football team. He played in four games with one start as a true freshman during the 2018 season, completing 21-of-42 passes for 255 yards and a touchdown.

THE YOUNG ONE

- SP Hagen Smith, Arkansas' youngest player as an 18-year-old true freshman, joins the Razorbacks' starting rotation this season.
- The heralded left-hander posted jaw-dropping numbers as a senior at Bullard High School in Bullard, Texas, going 11-0 with a 0.19 ERA and 168 strikeouts in 73.0 innings during his senior year. He walked 26 while allowing only seven hits and two runs all season.
- Smith tied a state record with seven no-hitters as he was named an All-American by both Baseball America and Perfect Game.

GETTING WIGGY WITH IT

- SP Jaxon Wiggins slides into the Razorbacks' rotation this season after emerging as a valuable arm as a true freshman in 2021.
- The Roland, Okla., native made 17 appearances, including four starts, last season, posting a 3-1 record with a 5.09 ERA and 28 strikeouts in 23.0 innings pitched.
- His four saves were second most on the Razorbacks behind only RHP Kevin Kopps (11), the 2021 Golden Spikes Award winner.
- Wiggins has quickly established himself as one of the hardest throwers in all of college baseball. According to D1Baseball, the right-hander has thrown the fourth-hardest pitch (97) this season.
- The right-hander is currently ranked No. 6 on D1Baseball's list of the top-100 college prospoects for the 2023 MLB Draft.

J.B. & JOHNELLE HUNT FAMILY BASEBALL DEVELOPMENT CENTER

- The J.B. & Johnelle Hunt Family Baseball Development Center is a 49,000-square foot baseball performance facility, providing student-athletes with an expanded locker room, team meeting room, strength & conditioning center, training room, nutrition center, pitching development center and an in-venue batting tunnel.
- The one-of-a-kind facility sits in the right-field corner of Baum-Walker Stadium, connecting with the west concourse and providing new premium seating areas for games. It also includes a tunnel to connect the facility to the first-base dugout.
- The Norm DeBriyn Champions Lobby features historical displays and interactive content showcasing the history of Razorback baseball.
- The \$27 million facility was funded entirely by athletic revenues, gifts and bond proceeds from a bond issue. No university funds, state funds or student fees were required to complete the project. The facility was approved for construction in June 2019 by the University of Arkansas Board of Trustees.



The \$27 million, 49,000-square foot J.B. & Johnelle Hunt Family Baseball Development Center is the only one of its kind in all of college baseball.

Dave Van Horn, the 2004 and 2021 SEC Coach of the Year, enters his 20th season at the helm of the Arkansas baseball program in 2022. In his 20 seasons as Head Hog, Van Horn has elevated Arkansas into one of the nation's premier teams. Van Horn has led the Razorbacks to six College World Series appearances, 17 NCAA Tournament berths, two SEC overall titles, six SEC Western Division championships, one SEC Tournament title and a total of 773 wins and counting.

Snce returning to his alma mater in 2003 to take over for retiring legendary Arkansas head baseball coach Norm DeBriyn, Van Horn has continued to successfully field nationally competitive teams while grooming two Golden Spikes Award and Dick Howser Trophy winners in Andrew Benintendi and Kevin Kopps as well as numerous All-Americans, all-conference performers and future professional baseball players. Under his watch, 34 Hogs have been named All-Americans, 41 as All-SEC players and 120 have been picked in the MLB Draft. Those 120 draft picks are third most among all active head coaches in the SEC.

Van Horn, who is the second-winningest coach in Arkansas history, has 303 career SEC wins to his name and is one of only five head coaches in college baseball history, along with Mississippi State/Georgia's Ron Polk (453), Ole Miss' Mike Bianco (331), LSU's Skip Bertman (328) and Vanderbilt's Tim Corbin (310), with 300 or more SEC wins in their career.

Including his years at Nebraska, Northwestern State and Central Missouri State, Van Horn has racked up 1,144 wins at four-year institutions, sixth most among all active DI head coaches. He is also one of six active DI head coaches with 1,100 or more wins at four-year schools.
