• **Co-Player of the Week:** Wyatt Langford, Florida
Florida's Wyatt Langford led the team with 24 total bases, 10 hits, four home runs and nine runs scored in five games last week as he helped lead the Gators to a series win against No. 5 Miami. Langford totaled six extra-base hits in 20 at bats and homered twice in the game one win vs. the Hurricanes. He had a pair of hits, including another home run, in the series-clinching win on Sunday.

• **Co-Player of the Week:** Charlie Condon, Georgia
Georgia's Charlie Condon batted .588 (10-for-17) with two doubles, three home runs and eight RBI in helping Georgia go 3-1 on the week including a series win over No. 16 Georgia Tech. His highlights included going 3-for-4 with two home runs and four RBI in a 16-6 road win on Saturday to clinch the series.

• **Pitcher of the Week:** Paul Skenes, LSU
LSU's Paul Skenes improved to 3-0 this season as he defeated Butler on Friday, limiting the opposition to no runs on one hit with no walks and a career-high 13 strikeouts in six innings. He allowed a two-out single in the first inning, then retired 16 straight Butler hitters to complete his outing. Skenes' 13 strikeouts represented the most by an LSU pitcher since March 2, 2018.

• **Freshman of the Week:** Colby Shelton, Alabama
Alabama's Colby Shelton hit five home runs, drove in 12 runs and led his team in nearly every offensive category during the Crimson Tide's four-game stretch last week. Six of his seven hits went for extra bases, and two of his home runs were grand slams. He homered in three straight games during the UIC series.

• This marks the final week of a full non-conference schedule before SEC squads begin conference play March 16-17. Ten different SEC programs are again ranked in the top-25 of the major polls entering the fourth week of the season. LSU remains the consensus No. 1 with an 11-1 record. Florida and Tennessee are ranked as high as No. 2, Arkansas is as high as No. 3, and Ole Miss is as high as No. 4. Other SEC teams ranked in the top-25 include: Vanderbilt (7), Auburn (11), Texas A&M (12), Alabama (18) and South Carolina (20). Alabama remains the SEC's only unbeaten team with a 12-0 record.

• A total of 49 SEC baseball student-athletes are eligible to wear the SEC graduate patch on their uniforms this season, signifying that they have earned their college degrees.

• Vanderbilt's Enrique Bradfield, Jr., recorded his 100th career stolen base last week. He stands seventh on the SEC's all-time career stolen bases list.

• Florida's Jac Caglione and LSU's Paul Skenes were named the national players of the month for February by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association. Caglione is the NCAA leader in home runs (10), while Skenes leads the nation in strikeouts (36).

• Four SEC coaches rank among the winningest active Division I coaches in the nation: Dave Van Horn (6th with 1,176 wins), Mike Bianco (11th with 963 wins), Tim Corbin (12th with 955 wins) and Jim Schlossnagle (18th with 862 wins).

Seeding

The two division champions shall be automatically seeded number one and number two based on winning percentage in conference competition. The rest shall be seeded numbers three through 12 based on winning percentage without regard to division. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

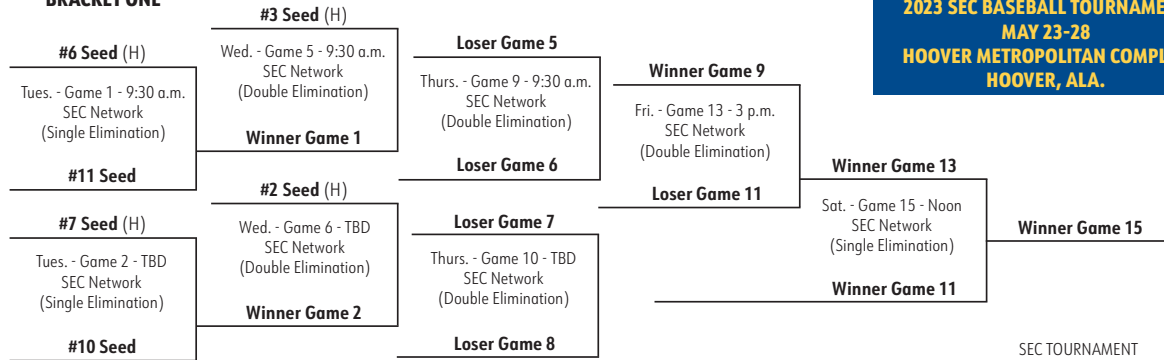
1. Two-Team Tie. The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
- If two-teams are divisional opponents:
 - Won-lost percentage within their division (over the 18-game SEC division schedule).
 - Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the No. 1 team in their division (and proceeding through the No. 7 team, if necessary).
- If two teams are not divisional opponents:
 - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary).
 - Coin flip by the Commissioner

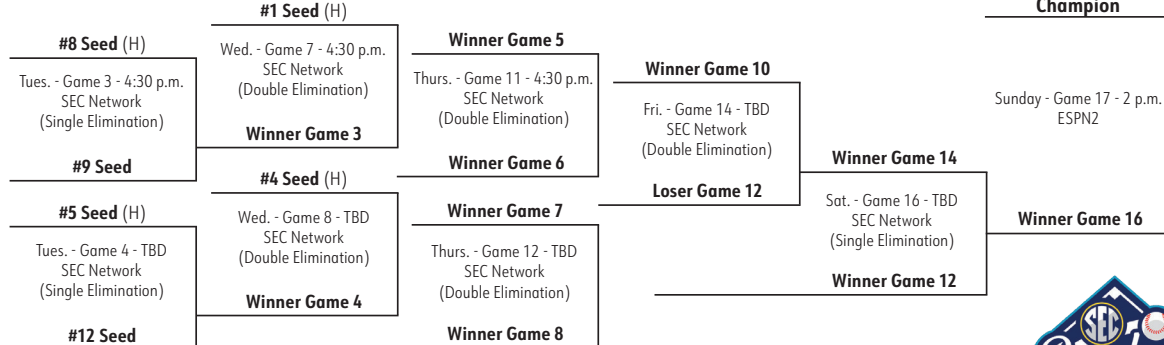
2. Three-Team Tie (or more). The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.

- If all three teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
- Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary, using common opponents only.
- If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.
