• Co-Player of the Week: Hunter Gilliam, Kentucky
 Kentucky's Hunter Gilliam had 13 hits last week and batted .619 with five doubles, a triple and 11 RBI, helping lead his team to five wins. He had three hits in three games and two hits in each of the other two contests.

• Co-Player of the Week: Connor Tate, Georgia
 Georgia's Connor Tate batted .600 (12-for-20) with nine runs scored, two doubles, four home runs, five walks and 10 RBI in helping Georgia to a 4-1 week. He tallied an SEC-best 26 total bases for the week and tied a school record by hitting a home run in three consecutive at bats.

• Co-Pitcher of the Week: Will McEntire, Arkansas
 Arkansas' Will McEntire threw a nine-inning complete game with six strikeouts against Louisiana Tech to help the Razorbacks clinch their 26th consecutive non-conference home weekend series win.

• Co-Pitcher of the Week: Thatcher Hurd, LSU
 LSU's Thatcher Hurd posted two wins in two starts last week, working a total of 11 scoreless IP with three walks and 18 strikeouts. Hurd allowed just four hits and limited opponents to a .111 batting average in his two outings.

• Co-Freshman of the Week: Charlie Condon, Georgia
 Georgia's Charlie Condon batted .476 (10-21) with seven runs scored, a triple, three home runs and 12 RBI in leading Georgia to a 4-1 week.

• Co-Freshman of the Week: Jared Jones, LSU
 LSU's Jared Jones hit .600 (6-for-10) for LSU last week with four homers, 11 RBI and five runs. He homered four times in four consecutive plate appearances.

• This marks the first of 10 weeks of conference play for SEC squads. Ten different SEC programs are again ranked in the top-25 of the major polls entering the fifth week of the season. LSU remains the consensus No. 1 with a 15-1 record. Florida, Ole Miss and Tennessee are ranked as high as No. 2, Arkansas as high as No. 3, Vanderbilt is as high as No. 6 and Texas A&M is ranked as high as No. 11. Other SEC teams ranked in the top-25 include: South Carolina (14), Auburn (18) and Alabama (22).

• Four SEC coaches rank among the winningest active Division I coaches in the nation: Dave Van Horn (6th with 1,180 wins), Mike Bianco (11th with 967 wins), Tim Corbin (12th with 959 wins) and Jim Schlossnagle (18th with 867 wins).

Seeding

The two division champions shall be automatically seeded number one and number two based on winning percentage in conference competition. The rest shall be seeded numbers three through 12 based on winning percentage without regard to division. Ties will be broken in the following manner:

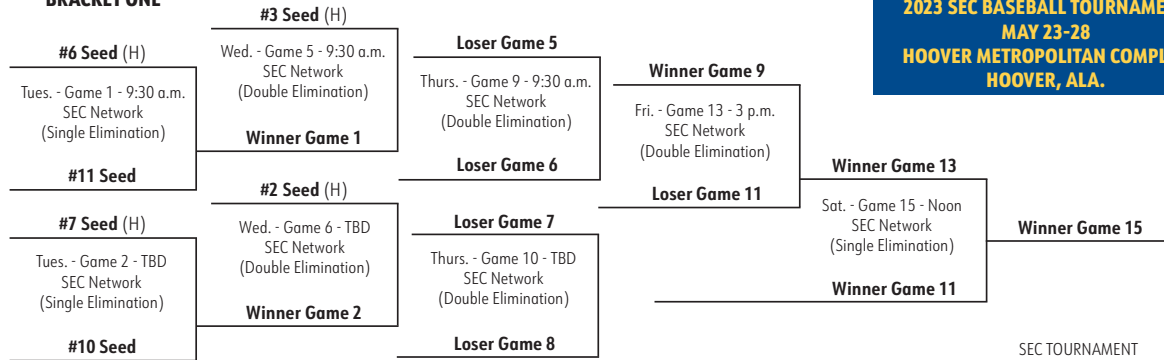
1. Two-Team Tie. The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken:

- Won-lost results of head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
- If two-teams are divisional opponents:
 - Won-lost percentage within their division (over the 18-game SEC division schedule).
 - Won-lost percentage of the two teams versus the No. 1 team in their division (and proceeding through the No. 7 team, if necessary).
- If two teams are not divisional opponents:
 - Won-lost record of the two teams versus the No. 1 seed using common opponents only (and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary).
 - Coin flip by the Commissioner

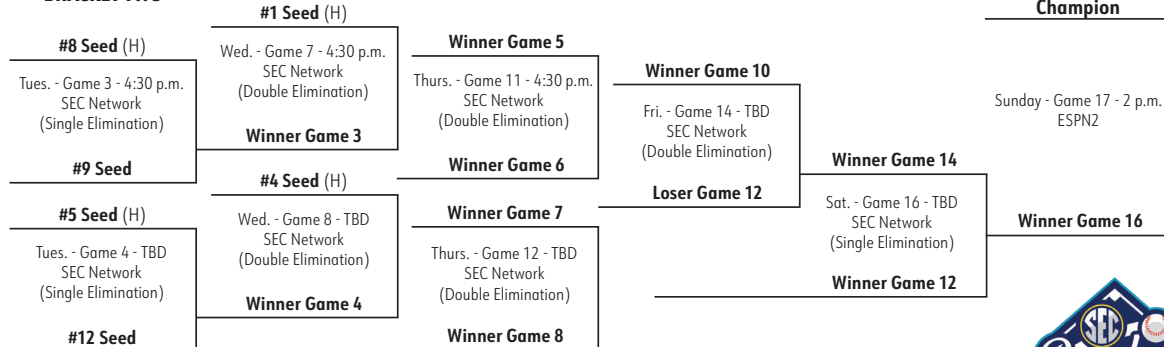
2. Three-Team Tie (or more). The following procedure will be used in the following order until the tie is broken: (Note: If the three tied teams have three different records against each other, they shall be seeded in best-percentage order.) Otherwise, once the tie has been reduced to two teams, the two-team tiebreaker procedure will be used.

- If all three teams are common opponents: Total won-lost percentage of games played among the tied teams.
- Won-lost percentage of the tied teams versus the No. 1 seed and proceeding through the No. 12 seed, if necessary, using common opponents only.
- If three or more teams still are tied, the Commissioner will conduct a draw.
