• BEAR TRACKS •

• **SERIES HISTORY:** UCA and Arkansas will be meeting for the fourth consecutive year and for the 14th time overall. Arkansas leads the overall series 7-4-2. The game in 2021 was the first between the schools since 1948, with all previous games played between 1921 and 1948.

Arkansas won last year's only meeting 6-3 on April 18 at Baum-Walker Stadium. The Hogs out-hit the Bears 13-7 and left 11 on base. UCA had the game's only home run by catcher Noah Argenta. UA's Christian Foutch picked up the victory with 2.0 innings or relief. UCA's Cade Fenton got the loss, allowing 2 earned runs in 4.1 innings of middle relief. He also struck out a game-high four batters.

Drew Sturgeon and Argenta both went 2 for 4 for the Bears. Five Razorbacks had two hits each.

• **LAST OUTING:** The Bears dropped a 5-1 game to Tarleton State on Sunday, the final game of a four-game series at Bear Stadium. UCA won the first two games 8-3 and 5-3, then lost the last two 6-4 and 5-1.

For the weekend, the Bears hit .262 and held the Texans to a .211 batting average. UCA's team earned-run average was 4.50 and TSU's was 5.06.

The Bears' pitching staff struck out 38 Texans and walked 18. TSU's pitchers struck out 32 and walked 16.

UCA had 11 extra-base hits, including four home runs. One of those was an inside-the-park home run by junior second baseman Tanner Leonard. The others were conventional homer by CF Drew Sturgeon, 1B A.J. Mendolia and catcher Casey Shipley. For the weekend, Sturgeon hit .500 and third baseman Bryce Cermenelli hit .357. Mason Griffin and Hunter Alexander both picked up victories in relief. Game 4 starter Payton Windham struck out a career-high 10 batters on Sunday in a loss.

• **IN-STATE GAMES:** The Bears handed in-state rival Arkansas State its first loss last Tuesday night, winning 8-4 in 12 innings at Tomlinson Stadium in Jonesboro. It was UCA's first of six in-state games this season.

The Bears, who won their fourth straight game, finally got to ASU reliever Coby Greiner in the top of the 12th, scoring four times on two hits and an error, all with two outs. UCA reliever Gavin Alveti then closed it out with a perfect bottom of the inning. Reliever Tate Busey got the win, going 4.0 innings and allowing just three hits and no runs while striking out three and walking none. Starter Payton Windham struck out 5 and allowed 3 earned runs in 7.0 innings.

Bryce Cermenelli had two hits for the Bears, while Drew Sturgeon and Preston Curtis has two RBIs each.

• **SIU WEEKEND:** The Bears swept a three-game series from previously undefeated Southern Illinois at Bear Stadium, winning 9-8, 9-8 and 13-12 (10 innings). For the weekend, UCA hit .353 and had a 7.39 earned-run average. The Bears also drew 24 walks and 14 hit by pitches to finish the weekend with a .514 on-base percentage. UCA was also 7 of 9 on stolen base attempts, including two each for A.J. Mendolia, Mason King and Preston Curtis.

UCA's victories on the mound all came from relievers Mason Griffin, Charlie Christensen and Hunter Alexander. UCA's pitchers combined for 28 strikeouts, seven each for Griffin and Alexander. Catcher Casey Shipley led the offense with a .417 batting average, followed by Drew Sturgeon at .400.

• **LSU WEEKEND:** The Bears went 1-3 in Baton Rouge, La., last weekend but played the defending NCAA champion LSU Tigers close twice and beat VMI once.

The Bears lost to the Tigers 2-0 on Saturday and 4-3 on Monday. LSU had a combined 13 hits and UCA had 12 in the two games. LSU had beaten VMI 27-5 on Sunday prior to the second UCA game. The Bears used just two pitchers against LSU, with starter Bryce Parlin going 2.2 innings and striking out three and sophomore transfer Gavin Alveti pitching the final 5.1 innings, allowing 2 hits and 0 runs and striking out 6.

In the win over VMI on Saturday, UCA got a two-out RBI base hit by Zeb Allen in the top of the 11th inning to win it. Hunter Alexander closed it out with a pair of strikeouts. In the season opener vs. VMI on Friday, the Bears were held to just 3 hits. Graduate Jesse Barker, Alexander and Parlin combined for 10 strikeouts and just one walk.

• **WALK IT OFF:** Senior first/third baseman A.J. Mendolia has broken the UCA career record for walks and now has 119 for his career. The old mark was set in just two seasons by Forrestt Allday, who had 110 in 2012-23.

Mendolia drew 24 walks as a freshman, followed by 45, 37 and now 13 so far this season. His career on-base percentage is .422. Mendolia has also been hit by a pitch 22 times.

Mendolia has played in 157 career games, with 155 career starts, and has 548 career at-bats. CF Drew Sturgeon has played in 158 games and has 155 career starts, with 544 career at-bats. The next closest is junior

- **NOTABLES:** The Bears rank fourth in the nation in hit by pitch with 31. They are 50th in walks with 67.
- Junior infielder Bryce Cermenelli had UCA's first three-hit game of the season last weekend (3/2) against Tarleton State. 3B/SS Mason King has the team's only four-RBI game vs. Southern Illinois (2/24).
- Junior transfer catcher Casey Shipley (Farmington, Ark./UA-Rich Mountain) has started the season by reaching base in all 13 games. Junior left fielder Preston Curtis and junior center fielder Drew Sturgeon both have 11-game streaks, while freshman Zeb Allen and senior 1B A.J. Mendolia both had 10 game streaks.
- Junior lefty Payton Windham struck out a career-high 10 batters on Sunday vs. Tarleton, which is a season high for UCA pitchers.
- UCA faced and beat its second consecutive undefeated team when it downed ASU last Tuesday. The SIU Salukis were 4-0 coming into last weekend's series in Conway. ASU was 8-0.
- The Bears have only committed two errors in the last four games. For the season, they have 13 in 13 games and have had 0 errors four times, twice at LSU.
- The Bears have seven wins this season and four have been one-run games.
- UCA is already 3-0 in extra-inning games this season after going 0-3 last season in extra innings.
- UCA head coach Nick Harlan passed Ronnie Kerr for 9th place in career victories in the win over Arkansas State. Harlan has now won 56 games and Kerr won 51 (1982-85).
- Bryce Parlin closed out Saturday's win over Southern Illinois, then pitched the first 3.0 innings of Sunday's Game 3.
- UCA received 18 free bases from Southern Illinois pitchers in Sunday's series finale (11 walks, 7 hit by pitches). However, UCA also left 18 runners on base.
- UCA had double-figure hits in all three games of the SIU series (11, 11, 14), winning two games by identical 9-8 scores and the finale 13-12 in 10 innings.
- The Bears have a pair of brothers on the 2024 roster for the second year in a row, Kaden Seldomridge and Hayden Seldomridge. Kade is a sophomore outfielder while Hayden is a senior transfer catcher from Central Arizona College. Both played at Rogers (Ark.) High School
- The Bears competed in the Southland Conference from 2007-2021. While in the SLC, UCA had a 204-232-2 record, and went 121-110 over the final eight seasons.
- Former Bear pitcher Gavin Stone made his MLB debut on May 3, 2023 for the Los Angeles Dodgers, starting against the Philadelphia Phillies. He was in just his third season of professional baseball. He was a fifth-round draft choice in 2020. His final game at UCA was a no-hitter against Southeastern Louisiana. UCA won 2-0 with Stone striking out 13 and walking one, facing 28 batters.
- Former Bear Jonathan Davis is currently with the Miami Marlins. Davis is in his 12th professional season and has played for the Toronto Blue Jays, New York Yankees, Milwaukee Brewers and Miami Marlins in MLB. He has 205 career games in The Show.
- UCA head coach Nick Harlan won his 400th career collegiate game on April 1, 2023 against Queens. His record covers UCA the past two seasons and his nine seasons at his alma mater York (Neb.) College. His overall record is now 414-244.
- AJ Mendolia reached base in UCA's first 26 games last season (streak stopped April 1), after reaching in the first 18 games in 2022.
- The Bears played three Top 10 teams last season, beating Vanderbilt 5-4 and losing at No. 1 LU 10-4 and 6-3 at Arkansas. UCA also lost to No. 15 Dallas Baptist 12-5.
- UCA was 13 of 14 on stolen-base attempts last season at Liberty, including 7 of 7 in Saturday's finale. They stole 10 of 12 against Bellarmine. For the season, UCA finished 94 of 129, the fourth-best total in school history. The Bears stole 58 (of 80) in 2022, the best since 2017, and were just 23 of 25 in 2021. The school record is 109 set in 1998.
- A year ago, senior RF Kolby Johnson set the UCA school record for career games played at 216. The record was held by Ethan Harris (2010-13) at 205 games. Johnson started 197 games, which is 2nd all time behind 199 by Barrett Ward (2002-05).
- The Bears also broke the single-season school record for home runs with 56 on the season. The old mark was 51 set twice in 2007 and 2009.
- In 2022, the Bears finished 18-12 in ASUN play in their first season but did not make the field for the ASUN Tournament due to a strange tournament format that rewarded teams from the East Division.
- UCA had 13 Bears who had already graduated with their degrees or were finishing them during the spring semester of 2023.

• **LAST SEASON:** The Bears finished 23-31 overall last season and 14-16 in Atlantic Sun Conference play. The Bears did not make the ASUN Tournament, finishing in a tie for ninth place, with the top eight teams making the field.

UCA had a signature win over No. 10 Vanderbilt, beating the Commodores 5-4 in Nashville, Tenn., on Feb. 21. The Bears also faced No. 1 LSU in Baton Rouge, La, losing 10-4 on March 21. The Bears completed their SEC trifecta with a 6-3 loss at Arkansas on April 18 in Fayetteville. UCA also faced No. 15 Dallas Baptist on May 9, losing 12-5 in Dallas.

UCA swept a pair of ASUN series, taking three games at home against North Alabama and winning three straight at Bellarmine in Louisville, Ky. The Bears closed the season winning 2 of 3 at home against Eastern Kentucky. A sweep would have put them in a tie for eighth place in the ASUN and possibly have gotten them in the tournament.

• **THIS SEASON:** The Bears will play another formidable schedule in 2024, taking on defending national champion LSU twice on opening weekend, play at Top 5 Arkansas on March 5, at perennial power Mississippi State on April 2, along with a home series against Missouri State.

UCA has a three-game series with Little Rock in the annual "Governor's I-40 Showdown" and will play Arkansas State and Memphis home and home as well. The Bears also have a four-game home series with Tarleton State on March 1-3 at Bear Stadium.

UCA has its home opener on Friday, Feb. 23 against Southern Illinois. The Bears will then play 13 of its next 15 games at Bear Stadium.

ASUN play begins on March 15, with the Bears hosting the Eastern Kentucky Colonels in Conway.

• **RETURNEES:** The Bears return 11 pitchers and 8 position players from last year's squad, including All-ASUN starter Jesse Barker. Five of the returning everyday players were starters a year ago, including center fielder Drew Sturgeon, third/first baseman A.J. Mendolia, third baseman/designated hitter Mason King, second baseman Tanner Leonard and shortstop Reid Bowman.

The Bears added nine new pitchers and 10 new position players.

• **LOSSES:** The Bears have to replace seven position players and eight pitchers from last season. The key losses are All-ASUN right fielder Kolby Johnson, a four-year starter who set the school record for games played last season, and two-year starting catcher Noah Argenta.

Johnson, Argenta, Evan Hafley, Connor Flagg and Dylan Cyr combined for 30 of UCA's 56 home runs.

Oliver Laufman and Dillan Janak both made 17 appearances on the mound, while Spender Nelson had 16, Brady Walker 14 and Cade Fenton 12, including several weekend starts.

• **ALL-ASUN HONORS:** Right hander Jesse Barker was a first-team All-ASUN selection last season after making 14 appearances, all starts, as the Bears' Friday night ace. Barker went 7-4 with a 3.00 earned-run average and had a league-high 109 strikeouts. He had a league-best three complete games and league-best 96 innings and was second in wins and third in ERA.

Barker was the co-ASUN Baseball Scholar-Athlete of the Year after graduating with a degree in general science with a 4.0 grade-point average. He was a two-time ASUN Pitcher of the Week and struck out 11 batters twice in conference play (vs. Stetson & Bellarmine), and had 10 strikeouts vs. Austin Peay. For his career Barker has 168 Ks, which ranks in the Top 10 in UCA history.

• **2024 ASUN TOURNAMENT:** The 2024 ASUN Championship will be played May 21-26 at Melching Field @ Conrad Park in DeLand, Fla., with Stetson University

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as the host. The Lipscomb Bisons are the defending conference champions. Kennesaw State won the title in 2022 and Jacksonville in 2021.

A year ago, Lipscomb beat Florida Gulf Coast 12-6 in the championship game and advanced to the NCAA Clemson Regional where it lost to Clemson (12-5) and Charlotte (9-2).

• **PRESEASON POLL:** UCA was picked ninth out of 12 teams in the ASUN preseason poll. Defending champion Lipscomb was the preseason No. 1 pick, with seven of 12 first-place votes. Florida Gulf Coast had two first-place votes and was second, followed by Jacksonville (1), Stetson, Kennesaw State (1) and Austin Peay (1). Lipscomb had three preseason All-ASUN selections, including the defensive player of the year.

• **COACHING STAFF:** UCA head coach Nick Harlan returns for his third year as the leader of the program and his 11th overall in the UCA program. Harlan was the Bears' associate head coach and pitching coach since 2013 and took over for the retired Allen Gum in May 2021. Gum finished as the winningest coach in school history.

Harlan, for first new head coach for the Bears since 2011, came to UCA in 2013 after serving previously as the head coach at his alma mater, York (Neb.) College, where he put together a 363-181 record from 2004-13. He led the Bears to a 24-29 record (18-12 in the ASUN) in his first season as the head man in 2022.

The Bears revamped their coaching staff this season, with Cody Davenport moving into the pitching coach role while retaining his duties as recruiting coordinator. Former UCA player Lance Spigner (1986-89) joins the staff as an assistant coach after a long and successful high school and junior college coaching career. Former Bear R.J. Pearson (2020-22) moves from graduate assistant to Director of Baseball Operations. Kollin Kendrick is the new Director of Analytics and Pitching Performance.

• **UPGRADES AT THE BEAR:** Bear Stadium will have a new videoboard for the 2024 season. The videoboard replaces the old scoreboard at the same location in left-center field. A booth for visiting radio/TV/overflow media was also added on the third-base side of the concourse level, opposite the ESPN+ booth which was added on the first-base side in 2023.

Two years ago, Bear Stadium featured new turf with purple foul territory last season, along with a new outfield fence and new bullpens for both home and visiting teams. The visiting bullpen is no longer in the field of play, but instead located just outside the right-field wall. That wall has been moved in to 305 in the right-field corner to accommodate the new bullpen. UCA's bullpen has been moved out from behind the hitting facility and is now located beyond the home dugout between the field and the hitting facility.

• **ACADEMIC SUCCESS:** Five Bears were named to the CSC Academic All-District team last season. They included senior right fielder Kolby Johnson, junior first baseman A.J. Mendolia, junior starting pitcher Jesse Barker, junior center fielder Drew Sturgeon and sophomore second baseman Tanner Leonard.

• **TOP 10 UPSET:** UCA knocked off No. 10 Vanderbilt for the first time 5-4 on Feb. 21, 2023 at Hawkins Field in Nashville. The Bears held the two-time NCAA national champions to just four hits by three pitchers. UCA starter Payton Windham went 4.2 innings in his first starter after transferring from National Park College, allowing just 1 hit and 1 run while striking out 1 and walking 3.

Freshman Coleman MacRae went 1.2 innings and allowed no hits and no runs, struck out 2 and walked 3 to get the victory. Junior Trent Gregson came on for the final 2.2 innings for the save, despite allowing a three-run home run in the eighth.

UCA sophomore second baseman Tanner Leonard went 3 for 3 with three stolen bases, while sophomore shortstop Reid Bowman had three RBI. UCA left just two batters on base while Vandy (2-2) stranded eight. Vandy used four pitchers and recorded 16 strikeouts with just two walks.

UCA was facing Vandy for the seventh time and was 0-6. The Commodores beat the Bears 5-2 in 2022. The win was the first over a Power 5 opponent since a 2019 victory over Oklahoma State. It was the Bears' first win over an Southeastern Conference team since UCA beat Mississippi State three times in 2013, two in a regular-season series and once in the 2013 NCAA Starkville Regional.

• **ASUN AWARDS (2023):** Junior left hander Payton Windham was named the ASUN Pitcher of the Week on Feb. 27 after tossing a combined 8 1/3 innings over two outings, allowing just 3 hits and 1 unearned run while striking out 5 and walking 3.

He got a no decision after a solid outing against No. 10 Vanderbilt in Nashville. He worked 4.2 innings in the 5-4 victory, allowing just 1 hit and on unearned run. In a relief appearance at Missouri State on Sunday, he went 3.2 innings with 2 hits, 0 runs and 5 Ks. For the week, opponents hit just .107 against him.

Jesse Barker, a junior right hander from Benton, Ark., was named the Pitcher of the Week on April 17 after his complete-game shutout of North Florida on April 14 in Jacksonville. Barker allowed five hits and struck out five while walking none to improve to 5-2 and lower his ERA to 2.56.

Barker earned his second award of the season (third overall) on May 1 after striking out 11, walking none and allowing two runs in a complete-game victory over Bellarmine on the road.

GOVERNOR'S I-40 SHOWDOWN: The Bears and Little Rock Trojans will compete in the fifth year (2020 canceled due to covid-19) of the "Governor's I-40 Showdown" in a year-long battle between the schools who are just 25 miles apart. The teams will compete for points in each sport that both schools sponsor, amounting to 15 contests with a total of 41 points available.

UCA easily won the first trophy in 2018-19, which wrapped up with the third of three meetings with the Trojans at Dickey-Stephens Park in North Little Rock, home of the Seattle Mariners' AA club, the Arkansas Travelers. Arkansas Governor Asa Hutchinson threw out the first pitch for the finale. There was no winner in 2019-20 because of covid-19. UCA won the 2020-21 competition 23-15 and 2021-22 battle 24-15. UCA again won last year's competition 20-19.

The baseball teams will close out the competition again this season with three meetings. The teams play in Conway on April 16, at Little Rock on April 30 and again at Little Rock on May 14. There will not be a game at Dickey-Stephens Park this season due to scheduling conflicts. UCA currently leads this year's standings 18.5 to 3.5.

• **DRAFTED:** UCA right hander Tyler Cleveland was drafted in the 14th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Seattle Mariners. He is UCA's 15th player drafted in the NCAA Division I era, and ninth since 2017. Left hander Noah Cameron was drafted the previous season by the Kansas City Royals in the seventh round (199th overall). Cleveland was also the eighth pitcher among those 15 players. Gavin Stone (2020, 5th round, Dodgers) is one of the Top 100 prospects in MLB. UCA currently has five players with MLB organizations, including Cleveland, Cameron, Stone, Ty Tice and Jonathan Davis.

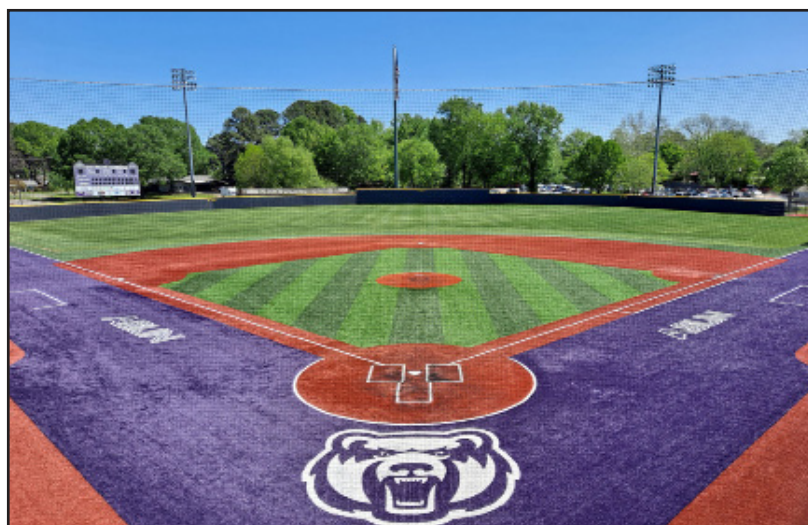

HEAD COACH NICK HARLAN

Nick Harlan was hired at the University of Central Arkansas as the associate head coach and pitching coach in August 2013, and was then named head coach in May 2021 after the retirement of Allen Gum.

Harlan joined the Bears after nine seasons as the head coach at his alma mater York College in York, Neb. One year under Harlan's leadership, UCA pitchers put together a great effort and notched a 3.58 ERA while helping the Bears earn a spot in the Southland Tournament Championship Game.

During his time at UCA's pitching coach, the Bears had six pitchers taken in the Major League Baseball Draft, including most recently, left hander Noah Cameron in 2021 by the Kansas City Royals. The others were Jeffery Enloe in 2013, Ty Tice in 2017, Tyler Gray in 2017 and 2018, Cody Davenport in 2019 and Gavin Stone in 2020. Tyler Cleveland was also drafted by the Seattle Mariners in 2022.

Harlan believes baseball is a great platform to teach disciplines that will build character and encourage young men to live with purpose. He believes that creating a culture of selflessness and accountability for consistent effort and competitiveness from his pitching staff will lead to success on the field and in life. "If we focus on the process of being the best men, teammates, and pitchers every day, we will make a greater impact on the people around us and give our team a chance for success." Harlan said.

Harlan was hired in 2004 as the head coach at York College. During Harlan's tenure (363-181 record) the Panthers won 5 conference championships, and earned 5 regional berths. During that time the Panthers were ranked as high as 8th in the country and in the top 25 for four consecutive years. In 2013, the Panthers earned a #1 seed in the Joliet, Ill regional, winning the regional and advancing to the NAIA World Series. York won a school-record 45 games in 2010.

Harlan was a two time MCAC Coach of the Year and in 2013 was named the York College Young Alumnus of the Year. In 2013 the NAIA awarded York College baseball with the Hank Burbridge Champions of Character award. The award is given to one team in the nation who exemplifies the 5 core values of the NAIA: Integrity, Respect, Responsibility, Sportsmanship, and Servant Leadership.

In 2003 Harlan was given the opportunity to go back to his alma mater as an assistant coach for one year under head coach Jerry Laird. Harlan began his coaching career in 2002 as an assistant coach under head coach Jedd Soto at Feather River Community College in Quincy, CA where he helped lead the Golden Eagles to their first California Final Four appearance and were awarded the California Pepsi Team Scholar Award for a cumulative team grade point average of 3.4. During this time he also served as an Associate Scout for the Philadelphia Phillies under Scott Ramsey.

Harlan was born in Oroville, California where he graduated from Oroville High School. He earned his Bachelor's Degree from York College.

Harlan married the former Lindsay Spivey, a UCA alum, on July 26, 2014 in Little Rock, AR. Nick and Lindsay share a home with their daughter Hazel Grace, son Walker Spivey and their dog Jesse.
