TCU NOTABLES

- TCU swept its season-opening series for the second straight year.
- The Horned Frogs are off to a 4-0 start for the second year in a row.
- TCU is now ranked in all five major polls, coming in as high as No. 13 in the Perfect Game poll.
- TCU debut six true freshmen on the mound and three in the field.
- TCU hit 11 home runs over the weekend, which ranks fourth in the NCAA.
- Two of TCU's victories have seen it rally from a multi-run deficit (4 runs on Friday, 3 runs on Monday).
- Cole Cramer was named the Big 12 Newcomer of the Week after hitting .412 with two home runs and six RBIs at San Diego.
- Noah Franco and Cramer both have a multi-home run game this season.
- Karson Bowen hit TCU's first inside the park home run since 2021 in Friday's win.
- Cohen Feser made his return to the mound for the first time since June of 2023.

NEUTRAL SITE/GLOBE LIFE FIELD

- TCU has played at least one regular season game in Globe Life since it opened.
- The Horned Frogs have played 24 games in Globe Life over the last four seasons.
- TCU is 17-7 all-time at Globe Life Field.
- TCU is 6-3 in regular season tournaments at Globe Life.
- TCU owns a record of 42-27 in Major League Ballparks.
- TCU is 25-11 in neutral site contests under the guidance of head coach Kirk Saarloos.
- TCU is 32-14 in MLB parks under Saarloos.
- Since Kirk Saarloos' arrival on campus, TCU is 75-39 (.657) in neutral site contests.

MICHIGAN NOTABLES

- Michigan is off to a 4-0 start after defeating Virginia, Rice, Villanova and Stetson in Puerto Rico.
- The Wolverines outscored their opponents 35-7 over the weekend.

ARKANSAS NOTABLES

- Arkansas swept Washington State to open the season.
- The Razorbacks put up 34 and boast a 1.91 ERA.

KANSAS STATE NOTABLES

- Kansas State is off to a 1-4 start to the season, going 1-3 in a tournament at Coastal Carolina and dropping a midweek tilt at North Carolina.
- The Wildcats have been outscored 45-28.

SERIES NOTABLES

- TCU and Michigan will be meeting for the second time on Friday.
- The two squads lone contest came in 2023 at the Houston College Classic with TCU winning 6-0.
- TCU Assistant Coach John DiLaura is a Michigan alum, playing from 2010-13. He was a volunteer assistant in 2018.
- TCU and Arkansas have played 73 times previously, with Arkansas leading the series 47-26.
- TCU and Arkansas met three times in 2023, with the Frogs winning all three matchups.
- TCU eliminated Arkansas in the Fayetteville Regional in 2023 en route to a CWS appearance, outscoring the Razorbacks 32-9 in the regional.
- TCU and Kansas State will be meeting for the 49th time in series history.
- TCU holds a 35-14 lead in the series.
- TCU and K-State are meeting in a non-conference game for the first time since the 1987 season.

FROG HOPS

- With four regular season crowns and four tournament trophies, TCU's eight Big 12 championships are the most of any program in the league since TCU joined in 2013.
- The eight total championships are the second most in league history.
- TCU was ranked in the preseason for the 16th straight season.
- Bill Mosiello returns to TCU after spending two seasons at Ohio State as the head coach where he put together a 60-51 record.
- From 2014-22, Saarloos and Mosiello guided TCU to a 355-165 (.683) record, four regular season titles, three Big 12 tournament titles, seven postseason appearances and four CWS appearances (2014-17).
- D1Baseball ranked the incoming freshman class No. 8. The group features 14 members.
- TCU has a pair of juniors that hail from the same high school in California. Karson Bowen and Louis Rodriguez both played at Orange Lutheran.
- TCU has two sets of brothers on the squad - Anthony and Jacob Silva along with Jax and Nolan Traeger.

SWINGING FOR THE FENCES

TCU club 11 home runs in the opening weekend of the season. It's tied for the fourth-most in the NCAA. There are seven teams in the NCAA that have double-digit home runs.

Seven Horned Frogs have contributed to the home run total and four of those Frogs have two home runs each. Noah Franco and Cole Cramer each have a multi-home run game.

Karson Bowen's home run was of the inside the park variety. It's the first one since Phillip Sikes hit an inside the park home run against Texas Southern on Feb. 23, 2001.

FRESH FACES

TCU debuted nine true freshmen over the weekend, three in the lineup and six on the mound.

At the plate, the trio of Noah Franco, Sawyer Strosnider and Nolan Traeger contributed on double, three home runs and six RBIs.

On the mound, Trevor Baumler and Zack James started, while Kade Eudy and Mason Brassfield each made two appearances. Nate Stern retired all three batters he faced in his debut and Kade Smith also made his debut. Collectively, they have a 5.26 ERA in 13 2/3 innings pitched with only three walks and 12 strikeouts.

IMPACT TRANSFERS

Nine transfers made their TCU debut between the field and the mound. The seven hitters combined to hit .351 (20-for-57) with five doubles, five home runs and 15 RBIs. Cole Cramer (.412) and Isaac Cadena (.400) were the Frogs' leading hitters over the weekend.

On the mound, Tommy LaPour and Gianluca Shinn debuted. LaPour tossed six shutout frames in his TCU debut. Shinn took over in a sticky situation and stranded two runners to keep the deficit at three runs.

WELCOME HOME

Coach Mosiello is highly regarded as one of the top offensive minds in baseball. In his previous stint with TCU, the Frogs had three All-Americans, three Big 12 Freshmen of the Year, two Big 12 Players of the Year and five freshmen All-Americans. Additionally, TCU produced 45 all-conference selections and 17 draft picks.

Under his tutelage, TCU twice led the league in batting average. Four times the Frogs surpassed the 100-stolen base mark. They ranked in the top 50 nationally in runs per game in six of nine campaigns.

In nine seasons under the direction of Coach Mosiello, the Horned Frogs hit .276 and averaged 6.48 runs per game. Six times the squad ranked in the top 23 nationally in stolen bases.

SPEED FACTOR

TCU continues to be one of the most prolific base-stealing teams in the nation. The Frogs have stolen 100 or more bases in three of the last four seasons. Since 2015, TCU has ranked in the top 10 nationally in stolen bases four times.

The Frogs are one of just 12 teams to have stolen at least 1,000 bases over the last 12 years. The 1,078 stolen bases rank eighth in the nation and third among Power 4 teams.

It's not just raw numbers that are impressive, the Horned Frogs have produced at a high success rate, converting on 80% of their attempts over the last eight years (1078-of-1353). No base is safe with the Frogs around. Over the last 12 seasons, TCU is 195-of-236 (83%) in stealing third.

NATIONWIDE

The United States is well-represented on the Horned Frogs rosters. The 40 athletes hail from 12 states spanning the continental USA.

There are 16 players from the state of Texas. California is represented by 13 athletes. Missouri is the only other state with multiple representatives with two.

Nine other states have one representative in Arizona, Florida, Iowa, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Nebraska, Oklahoma, Oregon and Washington.

INSIDE THE ROSTER

TCU returns eight players on offense and 10 members of the pitching staff. Additionally, TCU welcomed 23 newcomers, featuring 12 pitchers, nine position players and a pair of two-way players.

Five of the Division I transfers came from Power-5 programs (Jack Bell, Texas A&M; Isaac Cadena, Ohio State; Cole Cramer, Washington State; Colton Griffin, SFA; Tommy LaPour, Wichita State; Trey Newmann, Cal; Gianluca Shinn, Washington). Preston Gamster (Paris College) is the lone junior college transfer.

STINGY STAFF

The Frogs' 3.67 ERA since 2013 is fourth nationally. TCU led the nation with a 2.22 ERA in 2014 and ranked second in 2015 with a 2.45 ERA. The TCU pitching staff has produced four of the top 10 lowest ERAs in program history. Additionally, the TCU pitching staff is tied for the seventh-most shutouts (63) nationally over the last 12 years.

TCU has limited opponents to two or fewer runs 258 times in the 703 games played since Saarloos' arrival on campus. The staff has surrendered 5+ runs just 277 times in those contests.

K-ZONE

Over the last 13 seasons, TCU pitchers have struck out batters at a high rate. In 703 games, they have tallied double-digit strikeouts 301 times. TCU set a school record with 36 double-digit strikeout games in 2024.

They have produced seven of the top 10 season strikeout totals and boast a 9.12 strikeouts per nine average with Saarloos on staff.

The Frogs have ranked in the top 25 nationally in strikeouts per nine seven times. On three occasions, they have ranked in the top 10.

EXTRA, EXTRA

TCU has played 45 extra inning games since Kirk Saarloos arrived in 2013 and holds a 27-18 mark in those games. TCU is 8-1 in extra inning games with Saarloos as the head coach.

TCU played in three extra-inning games last season and went 3-0 in those contests. The Horned Frogs have won five straight extra inning games dating back to 2023.

The Frogs' longest extra inning game was 22 innings in the 2014 NCAA Regional against Sam Houston State.
