ARKANSAS DRESSING ROOM

COACH DANNY FORD: "Thank goodness our young people didn't give up when they had the opportunity to. When we got the interception and ran it to their 16, we really wanted to take it in and get a 10-point lead. That not only didn't happen but they took it to us on their first possession of the third quarter and took the lead.

"Give Pete Burks credit. He came back and made some big plays. He hit Anthony Eubanks twice on big third down plays on our touchdown drive. We've been looking for someone to make big plays and those were big. Oscar Malone ran with second and third effort. Our offensive line didn't do much in the third quarter but in the fourth quarter with the game on the line, they took over and dominated the line of scrimmage.

"Everything we do seems to come hard but this is the third year in a row we've defeated Ole Miss so maybe those people in eastern and southern Arkansas can live a little easier with those Rebel fans for another year.

"Other than the first drive in the third quarter, our defense was outstanding. We made some big plays. Other than at times against Auburn, our defensive line has given us great effort all season.

"For all the hard work this group has put in, I'm happy for them. We finally got a win in the SEC. I'm happy for our young people and the people of Arkansas. There were some happy players in our dressing room."

OSCAR MALONE: "Coach (Ford) told us seniors at the beginning of the week that it was up to us to get this team ready. We put it on our shoulders and I think we succeeded. I just want to thank God and my offensive line for helping me today. Our defense also did a good job of giving us the ball with good field position. The young guys on this team really came together and wanted to win this one for us. I think this win is huge for our team, not only because it was the last Fayetteville game but it was an SEC win, also. Hopefully we can build some confidence and use it the rest of the season. It felt good to run for over 100 yards again. What else could you ask for in your last game in Fayetteville? I'm also very honored to be named the Crip Hall Award winner. I think it means as much for the offensive line as it does for me."

MARK SMITH: "We needed to get everybody on the same page this week. I'm not a real vocal leader but I knew at the beginning of this week I needed to step up and get some guys' attention. I never tried to be negative but tried to build our guys' confidence. I think our defense did a good job holding Ole Miss to only seven points. We really tried to do what our coaches told us. This is a special win in Fayetteville because it's my last one. I've had a great time at school here and this was a great way to top off the last game. I'm hoping we can keep playing this well the rest of the season. We can do anything we put our minds to. We proved that today."

ANTHONY HICKS: "I can't tell you how happy I am to have won this game. Some people may have thought we would give up on the season. That's not the way this team is. I think we showed that by how our defense played and how our offense came back to win the game for us. I have to give a lot of credit to the other defensive players for my interception. They all played their positions correctly and it enabled me to get my first interception as a Razorback."

OLE MISS DRESSING ROOM

COACH TOMMY TUBERVILLE: "We have a running back that can make plays (Avery). He can make bad ones and good ones. He really earned his scholarship today. We did a little bit of stunting with our defensive tackles. We wanted and needed to get some movement. They got us a few times on the counter play. Their kid (Oscar Malone) ran hard. We really wanted to try to make them run the ball outside.

"On offense you can't abandon the run. You have to be able to run to be effective. Arkansas is doing a really good job of rushing the passer, which helps their secondary. Their defense did a really good job today.

"The backward pass in the second half took the air out of us. Avery hurt his ankle, so we took him out and the other back couldn't make the play. The pass was a little high.

"On their touchdown pass, they tricked us. We were playing underneath. We had a linebacker on the receiver. It was a good coaching move and a good chess game.

"Arkansas' defense stopped Fisher and Mangrum, our two best players. If we continue to stay in the fourth quarter of football games, we're eventually gonna win one. We didn't throw the ball deep very often because Arkansas was in a zone and played good defense."

JOHN AVERY: "We waited too late to play today. The whole week we practiced to the point where we could play with emotion and get Arkansas out of its game. During the first half, I watched the defense to see what it was doing. In the second half I went north and south and just tried to hit the hole. When we were down there wasn't any doubt we could take the ball down the field. You can't relax in the first half and try to come out in the second half and play catch up. We played with a lot of emotion in the second half. Our offensive line did a great job in the second half and I was able to read the blocks and get inside."

STEWART PATRIDGE: "We had the momentum whenever we were driving the ball. We just couldn't hold on to the football. You just can't do that and succeed. We always manage to shoot ourselves in the foot and stop ourselves. I feel I should have made some plays today but I didn't, especially towards the end. Arkansas' defense did a good job of controlling the line."

GAME NOTES
ARKANSAS VS. OLE MISS
11/9/96

Senior Oscar Malone made his last start at Razorback Stadium a memorable one today. Malone was named the Crip Hall Award Winner for the outstanding senior in the Razorback's homecoming game. Malone rushed for over 100 yards for the third time this season and the ninth time in his career, tying him with Bill Burnett for third place on the career 100-yard game rushing list. Malone's career rushing total is now 2,198 leaving him just 6 yards shy of tying Burnett for fourth place on the career rushing list.

Anthony Eubanks also continued to streak up the UA receiving charts. He has caught at least one reception in the last 22 games and has had at least three receptions in his last ten outings. In doing so, he passed Chuck Dicus into 5th place for most receiving yards in a season with 703. He also tied Dicus for season receptions in fourth place with 42. Also, Eubanks moved past Derek Russell on the career receptions list into 6th place with 93.

Anthony Hicks also had a memorable finale in Fayetteville, by grabbing his first career interception in his five year career as a Razorback.

With two field goals on the afternoon, Todd Latourette moved into 6th place all-time field goal chart with 20, surpassing Bruce Lahay.

OLE MISS POSTGAME NOTES

- ** Cornerback Derek Jones started today after missing the last two games because of a sprained knee and a deep thigh bruise.
- ** Center Matt Luke started today after missing the last two games. Luke has been the starting center in the first five games. He suffered a knee injury in the Alabama game. His backup, Boyd Kitchen, is out for the year after reinjuring his knee in the win over Arkansas State.
- ** Running back John Avery gained a career high 155 yards on 20 carries today. His performance is the 18th-best rushing performance in school history, tying Paige Cothren who gained 155 yards in 17 carries in a 26-0 win over Mississippi State in 1955. Avery's previous best was 98 yards in a 20-9 win at Vanderbilt Sept. 21.
- ** The last Ole Miss player to gain over 100 yards rushing was Artie Moore who ran for 112 yards in a 31-7 win over VMI this season (Sept. 7).
- ** Randall Green's 67-yard punt was his career best and longest for the Rebels this season. It tied Jim Miller (1977 and 1979) and Charles Childers (1990) for 21st longest punt in OleMiss history.
- ** Senior Lawrence Adams entered the game at quarterback in the second quarter. It was his first appearance at quarterback since 1993 when he started all 11 games at quarterback. Adams came in for two plays, running the offense out of the wishbone.
- ** The Rebels used three quarterbacks today, including starter Paul Head, Adams, and Stewart Patridge. Patridge entered the game for good on the second series of the second quarter (10:59).
- ** Freshman linebacker Armegis Spearman was used as the up-back in the Rebels' wishbone formation in the second quarter. He had one carry and lost one yard. He is the fourth two-way player for Ole Miss this season. Nate Wayne, Marty Stojkovic and Eli Anding, all linebackers, are the other three.
- ** Ole Miss is now 0-4 all-time when playing Arkansas in Fayetteville.
- ** Freshman safety Ronnie Heard recorded his third interception of the year.
- ** Senior Tn'Boris caught two balls and inched closer to the all-time reception leader mark. He now stands at 125 career receptions. Floyd Franks is the leader with 127 (1968-70). Willie Green ranks second with 126 (1986-89).
